Victor "Pops" Morgan, The Cottages of Middleton Part of The Cottages Family Since May of 2025

Victor "Pops" Morgan was born on May 30, 1933, in Winfield Kansas, where he grew up on a family farm. That instilled in him the values of hard work, humility, and helping others. In 1952, at just 19 years old, he was drafted into the United States Army and served two years during the Korean War, carrying with him a quiet strength and deep sense of duty that stayed with him throughout his life.



After returning home, Victor married the love of his life, Beverly, in 1958. Soon after, he earned his teaching degree and spent two years teaching industrial arts at a high school in Missouri. He later returned to Kansas, where he continued working as a welder before eventually moving to Colorado. There, he began what would become a 40-year career with Sears, working as a subcontractor installing garage door openers and other home improvement projects. Victor became a trusted, familiar presence in homes across the region.



Victor and Beverly built a life rooted in faith, family, and service, raising four children and sharing 65 years of marriage. Beverly later received Memory Care at The Cottages, where Victor remained faithfully by her side until her passing in 2024. They have 4 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.



Even now, Pops loves to stay busy. He can often be found building birdhouses or helping keep the flowers at The Cottages looking vibrant, tending to them with the same care he has always shown to the people around him. His gentle spirit, warm humor, and lifelong habit of serving others continue to make him a beloved presence to all who know him.
